HIV has not gone away. It's still a deadly disease in the US and nations around the world... and Charleston is in its bulls-eye. At 16.8%, the CDC found that people in the South are diagnosed with HIV more than any other part of the country, and worse, black Americans have the highest rate of HIV compared to all other ethnicities. Even though we're 12% of the US population, we make up 44% of those with HIV. (Hispanics and Latinos represent 18% of the population but make up 25% of those with HIV.)
